All arrears must be cleared and any dinners that are required over the next 2 weeks are paid for in advance.

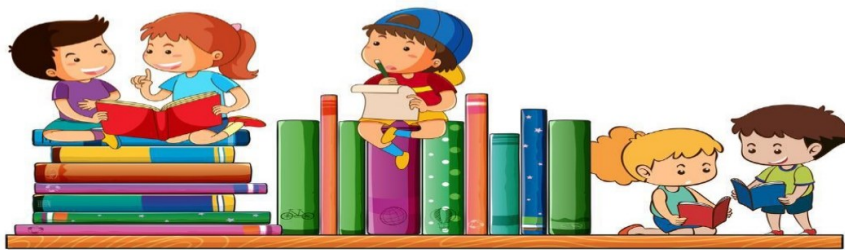
