Nursery Preview Learning

We have dived into our 'Under the Sea' topic SPLASH to see the last few weeks of the year out. We have explored many sea creatures already; sharks, octopus, stingrays, dolphins, fish and crabs.

We will be creating our own rock pool with soapy water for sea foam, small stones and an abundance of small-world rock-pool animals. We will dance to 'Octopus's Garden' by the Beatles and practise shark dot-to-dots with numbers to 5 and beyond.

We look forward to engaging with the children's interests alongside this learning and spending time with the children for these last couple of weeks before the end of term.
