### **Nursery Preview Learning**

## (Mini Moles – Children aged 3 and 4)

Welcome back Mini Moles, we hope you had a fantastic half term.

We have returned to our **BANG!** Topic.

This half term we will explore all things colourful from fireworks to Christmas lights. We will start the term exploring the dark. We will think about how our day changes from day to night, what our routines are and what we might see in the dark and compare that to the day.

Next week, we will be exploring shadows. We will use torches to create lots of different shapes as well as coloured cellophane to change the colour of light.

#### **Reception Preview Learning**

Welcome back to our BANG topic!

This will include learning about Bonfire night, light and dark, space and all things that happen in the dark. Children will learn about nocturnal animals and how the moon shines bright. Why not have a look at the night sky at home and talk about what you can see?
